CALL FOR APPLICATIONS TO JOIN MASTER DEGREE PROGRAMMES (NTA LEVEL 9) FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2017/2018

EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS (10th OCT 2017)

The Dar es Salaam Institute of Technology (DIT) invites applications from qualified candidates for the admission into Master of Engineering in Maintenance Management (**MENGMM**) and Master in Computational Science and Engineering (**MCSE**) Programmes for the academic year **2017/2018**, scheduled to start in **November 2017**. The programmes are offered by coursework and dissertation and have been accredited by NACTE. The programmes duration is 18 and 24 months for MENGMM and MCSE respectively.

Minimum Entry Requirements for MENGMM Programme

- [1] Applicants must be holders of a Bachelor of Engineering degree in either of the following areas of Engineering; Civil, Electrical, Mechanical or equivalent from an accredited higher learning institution; with a GPA of at least 3.0 OR
- [2] Candidates with a Bachelor of Engineering degree in either of the following areas of engineering; Civil, Electrical, Mechanical or equivalent from an accredited higher learning institution; with at least 2.7 GPA may be considered if they have an evidence of not less than 3 years working experience after graduation. OR
- [3] Holders of Advanced Diploma in Engineering in either of the following areas of Engineering; Civil, Electrical, Mechanical; or equivalent from an accredited higher learning institution with a PASS and a minimum of five years experience can also be considered.

Minimum Entry Requirements for MCSE Programme

Applicants must have a good background in mathematics at Bachelor level and must fulfil one of the following requirements:

- [1] Applicants must be holders of a Bachelor degree in Engineering, Science or equivalent with a GPA of at least 3.0 from a recognized higher learning institution. OR
- [2] Holders of Bachelor degree in Engineering, Science or equivalent of at least 2.7 from a recognized higher learning institution and with a minimum of three years of relevant working experience after graduation. OR
- [3] Holders of Advanced Diploma in Engineering, Science or equivalent with a PASS from a recognized higher learning institution and with a minimum of five years working experience after graduation.
