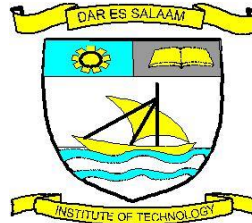

- (ii) Ordinary Diploma in Civil Engineering (Myunga Campus)-Songwe Region
- (iii) Ordinary Diploma in Computer Engineering
- (iv) Ordinary Diploma in Electrical Engineering
- (v) Ordinary Diploma in Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering
- (vi) Ordinary Diploma in Mechanical Engineering
- (vii) Ordinary Diploma in Mining Engineering
- (viii) Ordinary Diploma in Communication Systems Technology

- In order to pursue the following programmes (**xviii-xix**), a candidate must be a holder of a Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) with four (4) passes (i.e. D grade or higher) in **Physics/Engineering Science and Mathematics** and any other two Subjects excluding religious subject.
- (xviii) Ordinary Diploma in Multimedia and Film Technology
- (xix) Ordinary Diploma in Information Technology

OR

Possession of good General Certificate Course in Engineering (GCE)

OR

Holder of a Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) with a minimum of D grade in Mathematics and National Vocational Award (NVA) Level III or Trade Test Certificate of Grade I in the relevant field offered by VETA.

Applicants under private sponsorship are informed that Institute hostels accommodation is subject to availability of space

- B.1 All eligible applicants for Ordinary Diploma programmes are required to apply through DIT website <http://www.dit.ac.tz> through online link of admission.dit.ac.tz in which the information about the modality and procedures for application will be accessible
- B.2 **All eligible applicants for Ordinary Diploma programmes studied at DIT applying for re- admission at different levels (i.e NTA level 5, NTA level 6) after discontinuing and absconding from studies are required to collect application forms from the office of the Registrar in the Admission Office Unit.**
