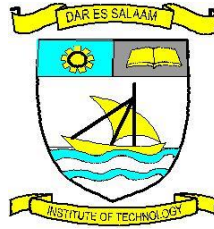

2ND ROUND APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION INTO BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/2020

The Dar es Salaam Institute of Technology invites applications from qualified candidates for the admission into the Institute's **Bachelor Degree** Programmes for the academic year 2019/2020 scheduled to commence in November 2019.

A: BACHELOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Programmes Offered

The Institute offers **THREE** and **FOUR** years' programmes leading to:

- (i) Bachelor of Engineering in Civil Engineering
- (ii) Bachelor of Engineering in Computer Engineering
- (iii) Bachelor of Engineering in Electrical Engineering
- (iv) Bachelor of Engineering in Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering
- (v) Bachelor of Engineering in Mechanical Engineering.
- (vi) Bachelor of Technology in Laboratory Sciences
- (vii) Bachelor of Engineering in Oil and Gas Engineering

A.1 THREE (3) YEARS PROGRAMME:

This is for candidates with Ordinary Diploma (NTA LEVEL 6)/Full Technician Certificate (FTC) who wish to pursue Bachelor Degree programmes in their programme of study.

Minimum Entry Qualification

Candidates applying for Bachelor of Engineering or Bachelor of Technology must be holders of Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6) or its equivalent in the respective field with minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 from a recognized Institution and at least four (4) passes (i.e D grade or higher) in relevant subjects at Certificate of Secondary

Education (CSEE) or NVA Level III or Trade Test Certificate of Grade I in the relevant field with a minimum of D grade in Mathematics at Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) or equivalent qualifications as established by either NECTA or VETA.

OR

Holder of good Full Technician Certificate (FTC) or its equivalent in the relevant field from a recognized Institution with an average of minimum pass of C or an average of minimum 3 points based on the following conversion scale: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 or its equivalent and at least four (4) passes (i.e D grade or higher) in the relevant subjects at Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) or Trade Test Certificate of Grade I in the relevant field with a minimum of D grade in Mathematics at Certificate of Secondary Education (CSEE) or equivalent qualifications as established by either NECTA or VETA.

A.2 FOUR (4) YEARS PROGRAMME (Excluding Bachelor of Technology in Laboratory Sciences and Bachelor of Engineering in Oil and Gas Engineering)

This is for candidates with **Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examinations** (ACSEE) or candidates with Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6) or Full Technician Certificate (FTC) who wish to **change** programme of study.

Minimum Entry Qualification

- (i) Candidates applying for Bachelor of Engineering for four (4) years programmes must be holders of Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education (ACSEE) in the combination of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Geography and Mathematics (PGM) with principal pass in Mathematics and Physics from the same sitting with a total points at least 4.0 based on the following conversion scale: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, S=0.5, F=0 for candidates who completed Form VI before 2014 to-date, and A=5, B+=4, B=3 C=2, D=1, E=0.5, F=0 for candidates who completed Form VI in 2014 and 2015. **OR**
- (ii) Candidates applying for a field of study other than a field studied in Diploma or FTC must also meet entry requirements stated in part **A.1**

C: MODE OF APPLICATION

- C.2** All eligible applicants for **Bachelor Degree** programmes studied at DIT applying for re-admission at different levels (i.e NTA level 7) after Discontinue studies or Abscond are required to collect application forms from the office of the Registrar to the admission unit.
